FINAL AWARD

The Project Director, National Highway Authority of India, Trikuta Nagar, Jammu vide his letter No.PD/JMU/13013/LA/5699 dated 24-01-2007, has placed an indent for the acquisition of land measuring 59 Kanals 15 Marlas in village Dhami, Tehsil Jammu for widening of National Highway Road under Khasra Nos. 169 Min (09 Marlas), 608 Min (04 Marlas), 609 Min (8 Kls 12 Mls), 168 Min (02 Kls18 Marlas), 171 Min (01 Kls 09 Mls), 167 Min (2 Kls 8 Kls) 134/1 (8 Kls 01 Mls), 210 Min (32 Kls), 170 Min (4 Mls) and 298 (3 Kls 10 Mls) totaling (59 Kls 15 Mls).

The instant acquisition proceedings were started by Sh.Hemant Kumar Sharma, the then Addl. Deputy Commissioner, Jammu (Collector Land Acquisition), but by virtue of his transfer as Member J&K Service Selection Board vide Govt. order No.528-GAD of 2008 dated 18-04-2008 of General Administration Department J&K Govt. Jammu, the District Collector (Deputy Commissioner, Jammu) vide his order No.ADC/Adm/PS/08-09/101-06 dated 05-06-2008 has authorized the undersigned to deal with the land acquisition cases of National Highway Authority of India in District Jammu.

Notification under section 4(I) of the Land Acquisition Act Svt, 1990 was issued vide this office endorsement No.DCJ/LA/ADC/235/06-07/525-29 dated 23-03-2007, where under the above mentioned Khasra numbers of village Dhami, Tehsil Jammu were notified for the information of all concerned that land measuring 59 Kanals 15 Marlas is needed for the public purposes namely for widening of National Highway at village Dhami, Tehsil Jammu. Objections were invited from the interested persons with regard to the acquisition of said land within 15 days from the date of issue of the notification.

The notices were also pasted on the conspicuous places of village Dhami. The Tehsildar, Jammu after the services of notice to the concerned persons returned copy of the same to this office vide his office endorsement No.73/OQ dated 09-04-2007. But no concerned land owners/interested persons filed their objections in this office within a prescribed period of 15 days.



Thereafter the case was submitted to the Financial Commissioner (Revenue) J&K Govt. Jammu vide this office letter No.DCJ/LA/ADC/235/2007-08/82-84 dated 01-06-2007 for issuance of declaration under section 6 & 7 of the Land Acquisition Act Svt, 1990.

The Financial Commissioner (Revenue) J&K Govt., Jammu has issued notification vide his office No.213/FC of 2007 dated 01-12-2007 under section 6 & 7 of the Land Acquisition Act Svt, 1990 for 59 Kanals 15 Marlas of land situated at village Dhami, Tehsil Jammu.

Consequent upon the issuance of said notification, notice under section 9 & 9-A of the Land Acquisition Act Svt, 1990 was issued vide this office endorsement No.LA/ACR/Notice-9/Dhami/08/460-63 dated 18-01-2008 whereby all concerned/interested persons were invited to attend the office of the undersigned personally or through their authorized agent within 15 days to state the nature of their claims to compensation and also objection if any in the measurement of land. But no land owner/interested person has filed objection within time frame.

The Tehsildar, Jammu vide his letter No.930/OQ dated 31-05-2008 has reported average/market rate of the land as under:-

- 01. Last three years average rate = Rs. 17,344/-
- 02. Prevailing market rate = Rs.1,00,000/-

The market rate of land of village Dhami as reported by the Tehsildar, Jammu appears to be on higher side. But on the other hand, even last three years average sale rates shown as Rs.17,344/- per kanal are not dependable as there, too, seem to have been place on rather lower side by the parties against the real value simply to save the court fee, etc. The undersigned has also visited the spot and found that land in question falls near village Dhami. After taking into consideration the report of Tehsildar, Jammu as well as other aspects like the location of the land near habitation of the village Dhami and Colony of Kashmiri Migrants at village Jagti which is quite adjacent to the proposed land, the present value of land to the tune of Rs.50,000/- per kanal is quite genuine. Therefore the rate of Rs.50,000/- per kanal proposed above is justified and recommended for adoption of the same rates for village Dhami, Tehsil Jammu.

Now the District Collector (Deputy Commissioner), Jammu vide his letter No.DCJ/LHS/PWD/AoR/JMU/PM-146/92 dated 15-09-2008, has conveyed the approval to adopt the rate of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousands only) per kanal as proposed in the Draft Award subject to the condition that before making the payment, clearance under LB-10 of 1980 shall be recorded/obtained as required under rules.

Therefore, I, Rajinder Singh, KAS, Assistant Commissioner (Revenue), Jammu Collector Land Acquisition, National Highway Authority of India for District Jammu hereby issue final award of Rs.34,35,625/- (Rupees thirty four lacs, thirty five thousand six hundred & twenty five only) for 59 Kanals 15 Marlas of land situated at village Dhami, Tehsil Jammu.

The notices under section 12 (2) of the Land Acquisition Act Svt.1990 shall be issued to the land owners/interested persons accordingly.
